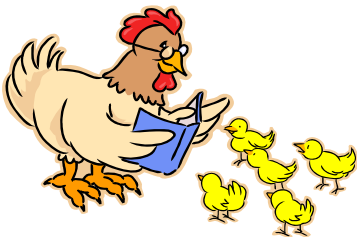

(*Call us if you need us to mail or e-mail the library request form.*)

**In order to maintain our library and to ensure that everyone is able to enjoy all the resources, we ask borrowers to follow a few simple guidelines:**

1. Please mail us the signed library request form of up to **3 items**, and indicate whether you will be mailing items back to us or if you need to make arrangements to drop them off at a Career Center near you.
2. Items may be borrowed for up to **three weeks**. ***Borrowers are responsible for the cost of returning the items.*** (If you find you need the materials for a longer period of time, you may request to keep them for an additional week, provided that no one else has requested them.)
3. Materials must be signed out through an RDC staff member. When you mail in request form, the items will be mailed out on receipt.
4. Materials must be returned in their original condition. Borrowers are responsible for the purchase price of any lost or damaged items and for the return of the replacement item. If the item is over \$25.00 please insure the item or get a return receipt in order to protect yourself.

We appreciate your consideration of this policy. With your cooperation, many child care providers and families will have access to free resource materials to assist them in their *work and play* with children.
